I now extend this invitation for you to come to the Lord's Table and of the Holy Sacrament.

Come, not because you must, but because you may.

Come, not because you are strong, but because you are weak.

Come, not because you are righteous, but because you sincerely trust the Lord Jesus Christ.

Come, not just to receive the benefits that Christ may give, but because you desire to be a true disciple of His.

Come, not to express an opinion, but to seek a Presence and to pray for a Spirit.

Come, not because you have any claim on heaven's rewards, but because in your frailty and sin, you stand in constant need of forgiveness and renewal.

Come, may this bread and cup be for you the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer of Confession

We come, not because we are worthy, but because Christ bids us to come.

We come, not because we have any merits of our own, but because we seek God's righteousness.

We come, not because of a sense of duty to the Church, but because this sacrament is the highest privilege in Christian worship.

We come, not because of our great love for others, but because we are drawn nearer to them in this fellowship.

We come, because we want to experience communion with God, our Sovereign, who was revealed in Jesus the Christ, and is ever present in the Holy Spirit, Guide and Comforter.

The Great Thanksgiving

Lift up your hearts! We lift them to the Lord!

Give thanks to God; remember God is so good.

God's love is everlasting. Praise God!

O God, merciful Maker and Sustainer, you have consecrated for us a new Way of life through Jesus Christ our Lord. Grant to us gathered here to partake of the bread and the cup that our hearts and our lives might be truly yielded to the call of His spirit.

On the night he gave himself up for us and for the world, at the table with those who would desert and deny him, he took bread, gave it to his disciples, saying:

"Take, eat: this is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

When the supper had ended, he took the cup, gave it to his disciples, saying:

"Drink from this, all of you; for this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

Now as we commemorate His last supper with His disciples, and the offering of Himself on the cross; we pray consecrate these gifts of bread and wine, which represent for us the body that was broken and the blood that was shed on our behalf.

As we receive this sacrament, may we be renewed in spirit and in our devotion to you, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Remembering the Lord Jesus, we break bread and share one cup announcing His death for the sins of the whole world, and telling his resurrection to all people and nations.

The Lord's Prayer: Our father, who art in heaven hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come; thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.
