RESPONDING TO GENERAL CONFERENCE CHANGES:

The recently postponed 2020 General Conference was indeed historic and there is a lot of information to unpack. One of the decisions regarding same sex marriages impacts local churches. The Trustees of each church have been charged with determining policy as to whether same gender marriages can take place in their buildings. To help our congregation understand some of the changes made at General conference and to gather input for the Trustees, the Church Council has proposed the following plan:

- Post General Conference Webinar Information Sessions (June 22 @ 4:00pm & June 23 @ 10:30am)
- 2. Post General Conference Q & A Sessions (June 25 @ 7:00pm, June 29 @ 4:00pm & June 30 @ 10:30am)
- 3. A mailed survey sent out to gather input from congregation. (**July 14** collection deadline)
- 4. Trustees receive congregational input and develop a Building Use Policy for the **Aug. 6** Church Council meeting.

We hope you will be able to attend at least one of the Post General Conference Information Sessions and/or Q & A Sessions in order to make an informed decision as you participate in the congregational survey. Your participation and input will be extremely helpful as our church leadership creates an updated Building Use Policy. Thank You.
