RESPONDING TO GENERAL CONFERENCE CHANGES:

The recently postponed 2020 General Conference was indeed historic and there is a lot of information to unpack. One of the decisions regarding LGBTQIA+ marriages impacts local churches. The Trustees of each church have been charged with determining policy as to whether LGBTQIA+ marriages can take place in their buildings. We also need to determine if our congregation would be willing to accept and support a LGBTQIA+ Pastor in the future. To gather input for the Trustees, the Church Council has proposed the following plan:

- 1. A mailed survey sent out to gather input from congregation. (August 4 collection deadline)
- 2. Trustees receive congregational input and develop a Building Use Policy for Church Council approval.

Your participation and input will be extremely helpful as our church leadership creates an updated Building Use Policy and profile for future pastors. Thank You.
